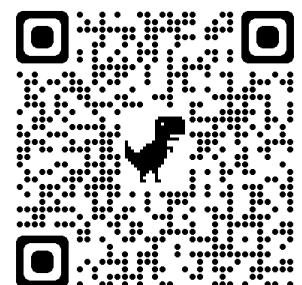

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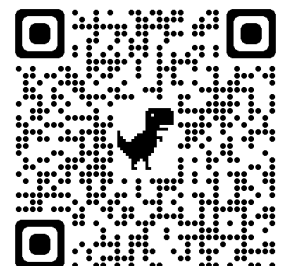
COMPETITION RULES:

1. Prepare 8 racks of baby back ribs (provided by Petaluma Active 20-30).
2. All contestants agree to have 70% of their meat cooked and ready to serve by 12:30 p.m. Judges turn-in time is 12:00 p.m. The remainder must be cooked by 2:00 p.m.
3. Each team will provide 6 ribs for judging. No garnishing allowed.
4. Check-in time will be Saturday, June 3rd between 6:00 a.m. and 7:30 a.m.
5. Meat will be given between 6:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. the day of the event.
6. Vehicles allowed in the cooking area prior to 6:30 a.m. for equipment drop-off only. Vehicles must be removed after equipment drop-off.
7. No vehicles will be allowed in or out between 12:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m. Saturday except for emergencies
8. No pets allowed.
9. Teams are required to ensure proper food handling procedures at all times – teams found serving undercooked meat or using unsafe techniques will be disqualified.
10. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies, including but not limited to:
 - a. Food safe cleaning equipment, Food service gloves, Hand & Surface Wipes, DO NOT DUMP your coals on the ground (we will provide metal can for hot coals), all fires must be in containers, Fire extinguisher for their space: minimum rating of 5lb type AB, Meat thermometer, Pop up/EZ Up tents are required by the Health Dept.
 - b. Must supply your own table for serving to the public.
 - c. NO STAKES IN THE GROUND – please use weights to secure tents, EX-ups, etc. If you use stakes and damage the water pipes – you will be liable for all costs to repair.
11. Any teams deemed handling/storing food in an unsafe manner will be immediately disqualified.
12. All teams must follow all Sonoma County Department of Health codes and regulations.
13. Spaces will be approximately 12' x 12' - Everything must fit within your space.
14. Absolutely no firearms or explosives will be allowed.
15. Each team will be responsible for cleanup of their space.
16. The Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guests.
17. Each team will be provided with numbered containers, for judging samples (no additional markings on box).
18. Teams will be provided with public serving dishes, napkins, and hand wipes. Anything additional is at the discretion and expense of your team.
19. **Festive presentation, decoration and costumes are encouraged!**
20. Food must be ready for sampling at 12:00 p.m.
21. Winners will be announced no later than 4:00 p.m.
22. Absolutely NO outside alcohol allowed. Alcohol must be purchased the day of the event (specific discounts available to competitors).
23. The Petaluma Active 20-30 reserves the right to make additional rules as necessary.

SIDE DISH COMPETITION RULES (All above non-rib specific rules still apply with the addition of the below):

1. Prepare a minimum of **100 samples** to distribute to the public for tasting.
2. Sides may be prepared prior to the event or during the event - team's preference.
3. Teams must provide their own serving plates/dishes, tools and equipment.
4. Judging will be based on people's choice vote and judge's vote (see prizes description).
